The above conditions will no longer be prescribed except in certain circumstances—please speak to your GP, Nurse or pharmacist

#### Changes to the way you order your repeat prescription



From 4th March The Pines Surgery will introduce a new system which means you will need to order repeat prescriptions yourself. Pharmacies and dispensing companies will no longer be able to do this for you.

#### What do I need to do?

There are different ways to order, including:

- using SystmOnline patient online service
- downloading the SystmOnline app to your smartphone or tablet device
- handing in the white, tear-off part of your repeat prescription to your GP practice
- writing a letter to your GP practice.

If you need more information, please speak to staff at your GP practice or pick up a leaflet from your practice or local pharmacy.

The surgery would ask patients to please be mindful of how and where you park your vehicle when using the surgery car park. Under no circumstances should the Doctors parking bays be blocked as Doctors have to deal with emergencies..

#### **Electronic Prescription Service**

The Electronic Prescription Service (EPS) allows prescriptions to be sent direct to pharmacies through IT systems used in GP surgeries.

Eventually EPS will remove the need for most paper prescriptions.

You can collect repeat prescriptions directly from your pharmacy without visiting your GP!

To use this service all you need to do is choose which pharmacy you would like your prescriptions to be sent to.

To nominate to use EPS please talk to your pharmacy or to reception.
